

TRAIL ETIQUETTE

- The most important rule is to always be considerate of other trail users!
- Ride single file and be predictable: travel in a straight line.
- Yield to the slower trail user (Example: Bicyclist yield to pedestrians).
- Move well off the trail when stopped. Don't block the trail.
- Keep kids and pets under control.
- Use hand signals.
- Remove litter from the trail.
- Max speed 15 mph.

WHEN PASSING OTHER TRAIL USERS

- Slow down.
- Give an audible warning, "passing on your left".
- Pass on the left.

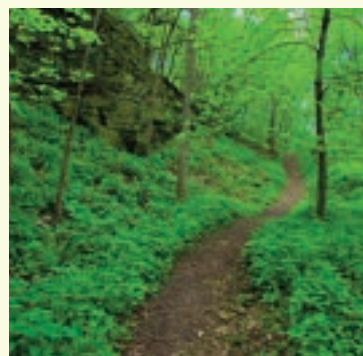

TRAIL INFORMATION

Rock County serves as the gateway to Wisconsin's Ice Age Trail segment and boasts an outstanding selection of recreational trails to meet the needs of residents and visitors alike. Whether you're traveling on two wheels or two feet, you can bike, hike, horseback ride or simply enjoy taking a walk along miles of trails, including the over 21 miles of the Ice Age Trail that wind their way through Rock County. The full Ice Age Trail is a thousand-mile footpath highlighting the remnants left behind by glaciers during the last ice age over 12,000 years ago. Designated as a National Scenic Trail, the Ice Age trail follows the terminal moraine of the last glaciation throughout Wisconsin providing some of the world's best examples of glacial formations such as kettles, moraines, and drumlins.

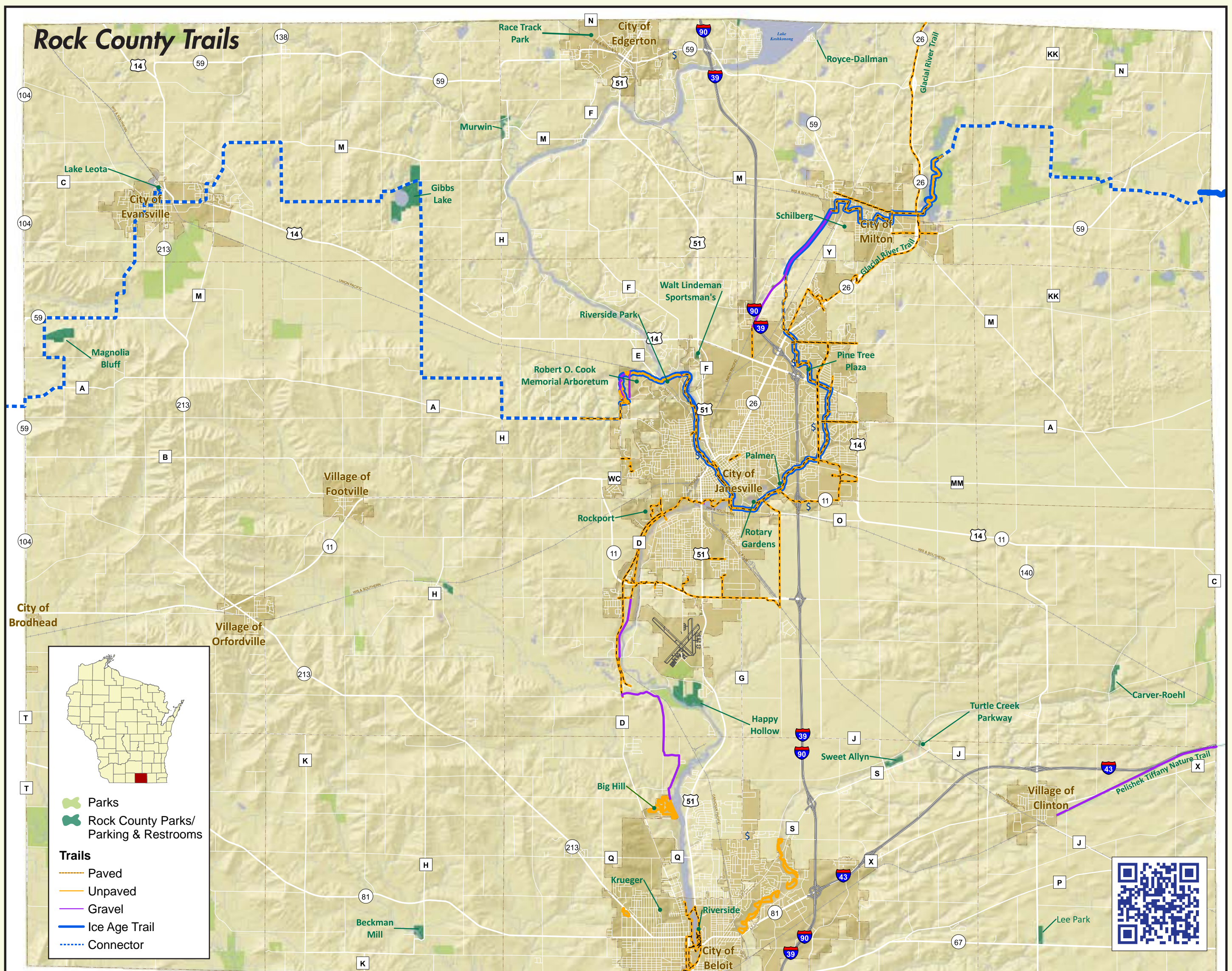

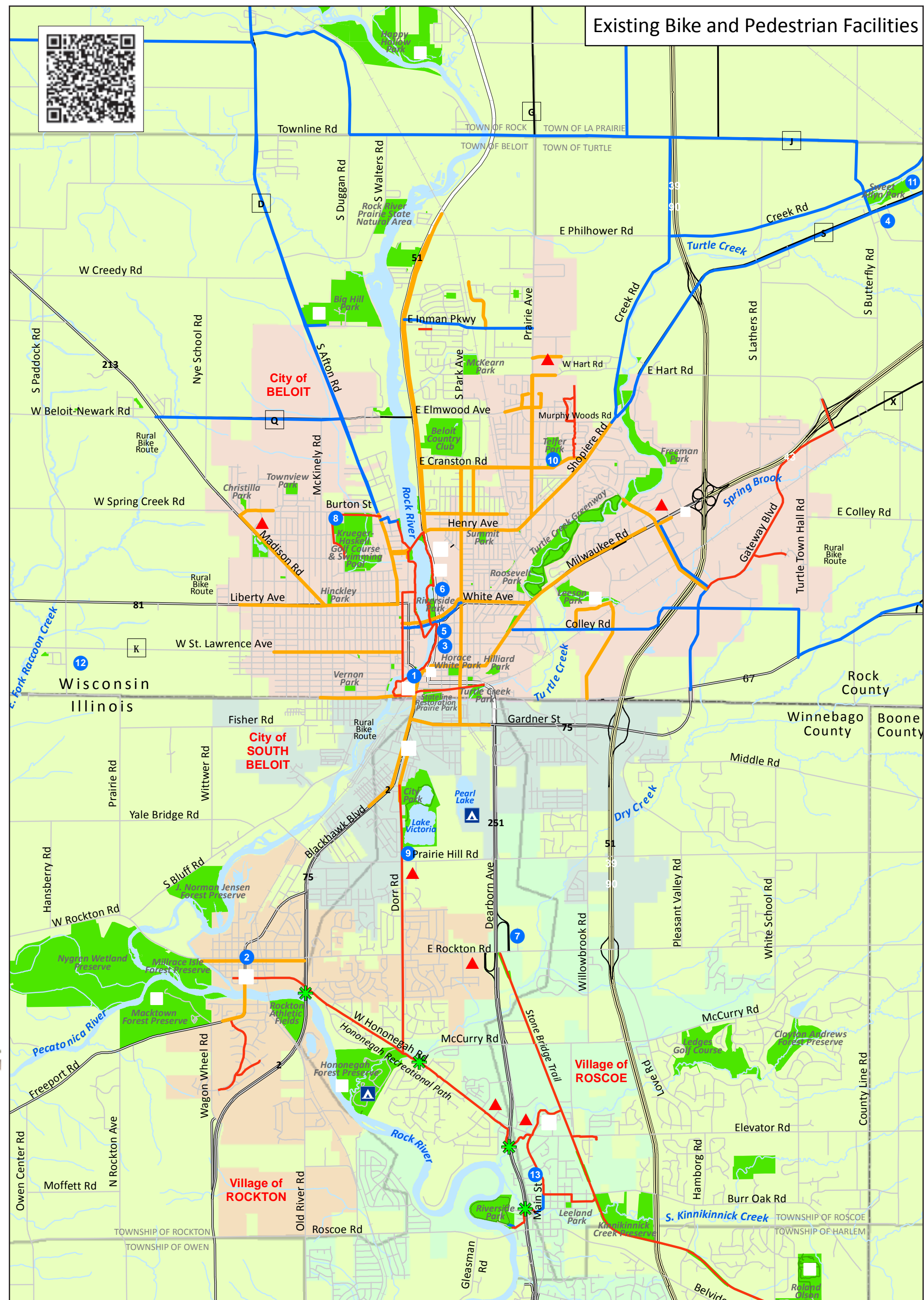

HUB OF THE JANESVILLE TRAILS SYSTEM

Janesville's paved trails are connected by one central point or 'hub,' and named trails radiate out from this point like spokes on a wheel. This hub is located just north of the old railroad bridge which spans the Rock River, where Riverside Street meets the trail. All trail mileage begins from this Hub.
